Employee Assistance Program (EAP)

- Provided by Humana.
- All services listed are free for employees and their household members.
- Assists employees with a wide range of support for family, marital, work-life challenges, stress, or parenting.
- All EAP services to employees are confidential and are not reported to colleagues, departments, supervisors, administration, or to the Department of Human Resources Management. All types of contact you make with the EAP remain confidential – permanently.

Free Resources

There are 3 ways to use the Employee Assistance Program.

- 1. Humana hosts a **web portal** that includes articles, financial calculators, and webinars that address a wide variety of issues.
- 2. You have unlimited **telephone** access to personal guidance, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The staff are experienced, certified, and licensed professionals.
- 3. You also have the availability to access 3 face-to-face **counseling sessions** per issue, per year. These may be scheduled with professional practices in your area.

Additional Services

Additional services include:

- Tools for managers
- Health and Wellness Resources
- Financial Services including free 30-minute consultations with financial professionals. Additional tax preparation services are eligible for a 25% discount from participating providers.
- Legal Services* including free 30-minute consultations with attorneys. Additional legal services are eligible for a 25% discount from participating providers.
- A personalized Life Coaching program. Once paired with a coach, sessions are available through the phone and are unlimited.
